The BRCF Management Committee is a standing committee of SELT and reports to SELT's Land Stewardship Committee. The members of the BRCF Management Committee provide invaluable time and information to ensure the overall BRCF Management Plan accurately reflected the values and interests of the greater New Durham community.

The BRCF Management Committee meets about three times a year, and more often as the Committee or SELT may require. Meetings have typically been held in the spring (March or April) and Fall (September & October) to coincide with planning and budgeting periods.
