



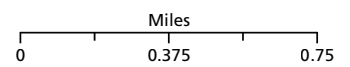

- Control your dog(s). Be aware where they may be required to be on leash or any areas they may not be allowed
- Hunting is allowed. Be aware of hunting seasons and wear blaze orange for your own safety.
